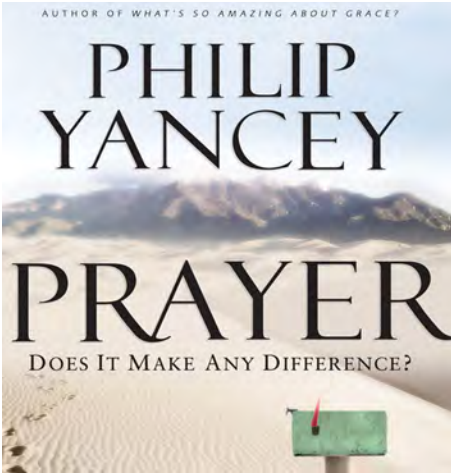
We're getting together for a visit to the Dufferin County Museum! Join us for a great time together followed by lunch at a restaurant!
