Inner healing Training opportunity

Restoring The Foundations (RTF) ministries is offering training seminars to help you learn inner healing tools that will help you and those you care for in life or ministry. These simple tools are based on Biblical principles that bring greater freedom, peace and joy in life. Topics covered will include generational sins, ungodly beliefs, forgiveness, repentance and deliverance.

The first Training opportunity is being held April 8, 15, 20 and 22 from 7-10pm at Catch The Fire Church on Attwell Drive. The cost is \$100 plus a manual fee of \$45. For those who already took this course and want to attend as a refresher, there is no fee.

NRCC is hoping to offer the second Training in June if there is enough interest. George and Laurie Hull will be leading us in applying the inner healing ministry tools as we walk through the healing process with each other in small groups of 3. The first training is a prerequisite for this course and a commitment to attend all classes is important. The cost for this has been reduced to \$175 for NRCC people. The time commitment will be a Thursday night, all day Friday and all day Saturday. Dates are pending.

I cannot say enough about the positive impact these tools have had on my own life and ministry. I wish I had known these tools 25 years ago. I have seen people freed from anger, fear, negativity, control, and generational sins that can be traced back for decades.
